Preparation for Colonoscopy with Miralax & Dulcolax
are scheduled for a Colonoscopy on at The facility may call you to change arrival time
hase at the pharmacy: 4 (four) Dulcolax 5mg tablets (Laxative) over the counter, a 238gram Miralax and a rade 64oz. (NO RED OR PURPLE) or you can use water. If you are a diabetic on insulin, you should buy tal Light or other sugar free clear liquid instead of Gatorade.
one week prior to the procedure: Do not take diet pills or smoke marijuana.
r liquids that you can take are the following: (A CLEAR LIQUID DIET MEANS NOTHING TO EAT) r bouillon, broth or consommé, tea, coffee, decaffeinated tea or coffee, Kool-Aid, carbonated beverages. Do not ny milk or cream in your tea or coffee. Juices including clear cranberry, white grape, and clear apple juice, ned lemonade, limeade, any juices that you can see through and has no pulp. Also acceptable is water ices, n ices, popsicles, and you can have jello (NO Red or Purple).
day before the procedure:
 Clear liquids diet (all day) from the time you wake up. Any time from 3:00 pm to 6:00 pm take the 4 Dulcolax tablets at once. Two hours after you have taken the 4 Dulcolax you will mix the 238grams bottle of Miralax into the 64oz Gatorade. Mix the solution until the powder dissolves. Drink an 8ox glass every 20 minutes until the solution is finish, you can drink faster if you like Continue drinking clear liquids until bedtime if you wish. No more drinking after midnight.
ne day of the procedure:
Do not eat or drink anything that day, unless the medicines approved by your doctor. If you must take any medication, you may drink it with a small amount of water. You should take your blood pressure pills. Please call # 305-674-5925 options #2 if you have any questions.
NO DRIVING You cannot drive; use a bus or taxi after the procedure by yourself. You must be accompanied by an adult. If this procedure is not followed, the hospital or endoscopy center may cancel your appointment.
